At 4:45 p.m., Monday, August 2, the members of the Davie County Board of Elections met for the monthly meeting. Present were: Gary Leblanc, Faye Carter, Luther Potts, Carole Demmy, Robert Raisbeck, Melissa Parker, and Tabatha Parrish.

Board and staff discussed one stop voting and the option for transferring voters from the North Mocks County precinct to the North Mocks City precinct for the November 2, 2021 Municipal General Election.

Director Parrish reported to the Board that precinct judge surveys had been sent to all currently appointed judges. Thirty eight of forty two surveys have been returned. Of the surveys returned, all except five are willing to be reappointed. Currently the Fulton, South Mocksville and East Shady Grove precincts have an opening for a democratic judge. North Calahaln and Hillsdale precincts have an opening for a Republican Judge.

The minutes from the July 6th and July 20th meeting were reviewed. Faye Carter moved the approval of the minutes. The minutes were unanimously approved.

The meeting adjourned at 4:55 pm.
