Gary Leblanc, Faye Carter, Luther Potts, Robert H. Raisbeck Jr., and Carole Demmy were sworn in by Ellen Drechsler. The board proceeded to conduct the organizational meeting for the Davie County Board of Elections.

Robert Raisbeck moved to nominate Faye Carter as Secretary of the Davie County Board of Elections. Luther Potts seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

The board reviewed the Director designation of duties. Robert Raisbeck moved the approval, Carole Demmy seconded and the motion passed unanimously. The Director designation of duties was signed by all board members.

Director Parrish provided the Board 2021 Election Schedule and 2021 Board Meeting Schedule.

The Board scheduled the monthly business meetings for the first Monday of each month at 4:45 beginning in August 2.

Director Parrish reported to the Board that precinct judge surveys had been sent to all currently appointed judges. Thirty one of forty two have been returned. Of the surveys returned, all except for 2 are willing to be reappointed. Currently the South Mocksville precinct has an opening for a democratic judge and the North Calahaln precinct has an opening for a Republican Judge.
