 - Fourth quarter/end of year Envisio report tabulations input at June end.
- Accessibility for Parks grant preparation is underway. Project timeline developed on 5/12. Justification page draft in progress. County CIP includes our project and approved by BOC on 6/6. Basic assurances and fact submitted to county attorney. Anticipate public input meetings in July and August.
- Community Recreation Agency Grant
 - Award letters drafted 5/23 and 5/24.
