Programs & Athletics

Athletics

- Youth Lacrosse League: we had the opportunity to host home games for 3-4 Boys on May 1 and 5-6 Boys on May 8!
- Youth Volleyball League has started with our 2 division, totally to 58 players.
- Adult Softball Church League has started games, 7 teams this season.
- Senior Services Senior Games Events are scheduled. DCRP has hosted Bocce and Basketball Shooting. We will be hosting and running Pickleball and Cornhole this May.

Programs

- Mid-Eastern Martial Arts: has continue to increased participants, April totaled to 60.
- Dance/Tumbling Programs will wrap up in May with Session 3 with 36 participants.
- Zumba: Registered participants continue to stay stead. April had 7 monthly registrations with 39 total drop-ins. Saturday classes start in May
