New restroom renovations are complete. Closure of right-of-way is in progress in order to move forward on gatehouse project.

- Park projects in progress
 - Dog Park Activity Course: Estimated shipping date is 5/4. Installation anticipated in May.
 - Amphitheater extended concrete project: Anticipated completion by 5/27.
 - Park greenway re-paving (safety) – Anticipated completion by 5/27.
- Created vision and goal data document stemming from advisory board roundtable. DCRP staff completed data entry and made additions. Advisory board to review on 5/9.
- DCRP staff are still working through performance agreements with potential vendor(s) in reference to alcohol sales for summer concerts.

- Greenway feasibility study:
 - Completed public input meeting at DCCP on 4/26 and 4/27.
 - Alta reported that over 100 surveys submitted thus far. Survey is active until May 13.

- Met with members of JCPC and Piedmont Mediation to discuss potential partnership opportunities on 4/21.
- Paul and Whitney met with Dr. Joel Edwards to discuss future logistics of The Park at Lake Louise in addition to grant opportunities for a connecting the park to Cornatzer Elementary.
- Paul and Whitney gave presentation to BOC on 5/2 in reference to Accessibility for Parks grant. BOC voted 5-0 to approve the following. To allow DCRP to move forward on AFP application. Approve up to \$100,000 in local matching funds request. Approval of DCCP Site and Master Plan (full build out).
