At 4:45 p.m., Tuesday, May 3, the members of the Davie County Board of Elections met for an absentee meeting. Present were Gary LeBlanc, Faye Carter, Luther Potts, Robert Raisbeck, Carole Demmy, Melissa Parker and Tabatha Parrish.

Twelve civilian absentee ballots were reviewed. Eleven ballots were found to be properly signed and witnessed and one ballot was missing the voter's signature which may be cured. Faye Carter moved to approve the eleven ballots and to send a cure letter to the voter to obtain the missing signature. The motion was unanimously approved. One military absentee ballot was reviewed and found to be properly signed. Carole Demmy moved to approve the ballot. The motion was unanimously approved. The approved ballots were removed from the envelopes and scanned into the DS200 in the presence of the Board.

Eight hundred fifty five one-stop applications were reviewed. Faye Carter moved to approve the applications. The motion was unanimously approved.

The minutes from the April 19 and 26 meetings were reviewed. Luther Potts moved the approval of the minutes. The motion was unanimously approved.
