At 4:45 p.m., Monday April 5, the members of the Davie County Board of Elections met for the monthly meeting. Present were: Gary Leblanc, Faye Carter, Luther Potts, Robert H. Raisbeck Jr., and Tabatha Parrish. Thomasine Gaither also attended the meeting.

Director Parrish reported to the Board that precinct workers had not received a raise in several years and were behind in compensation when being compared to other counties. The recommendation was for Chief Judge - \$250.00 for Election Day and training, Judge – \$185.00 for Election Day and training, and Assistants \$140.00 for Election Day and \$20.00 to attend training. Robert Raisbeck moved to approve the recommended wage increases for precinct workers. Faye Carter seconded the motion and the motion was unanimously approved.

Board and staff discussed ideas for voter registration drives including possible events at vaccine clinics, summer concert series, Davie High School and senior services.

There are no updates from county management regarding compensation for overtime worked during 11/03/2020 Presidential Election. Item will be revisited at the May board meeting.

The minutes from the March 1 meeting were reviewed. Luther Potts moved the approval of the minutes, Robert Raisbeck seconded the motion and the minutes were unanimously approved.

The meeting adjourned at 5:10 pm.
