PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD RULES

Revised: October 5, 2020

1. Thirty minutes before each regular monthly meeting of the Board of County Commissions of Davie County, a sign-up sheet shall be placed on the podium in the Davie County Commissioners meeting room on the second floor of the Administrative Office Building located at 123 South Main Street, Mocksville, North Carolina for anyone wishing to speak at the regular monthly meeting during the public comment period. In the event the regular monthly meeting location has changed, the sign-up sheet shall be placed on the podium at the changed location of the meeting. There shall be no advanced sign-ups allowed before this time.
2. Each person desiring to speak during the public comment shall sign up on the sign-up sheet provided and shall state fully their name, and topic on which he or she desire to speak. If the speaker has already discussed the topic with a particular staff member before the meeting, he or she shall identify the name of the staff member.
3. All speakers will be acknowledged by the Board or its designee in the order in which their names appear on the sign-up sheet.
4. Each speaker shall be allowed a total of three (3) minutes to speak and shall immediately stop when his or her three (3) minutes are up. If the speaker does not stop at the end of his/her time period, the speaker shall be considered as interrupting or disrupting a meeting under N.C.G.S. 143-318.17 and shall be subject to the criminal laws of the State of North Carolina. In the event the speaker is speaking for an organized group, the speaker shall be allowed a total of five (5) minutes. All organized groups shall designate a single representative speaker so as to economize time and avoid duplication. In the event several individuals have signed up for the same topic and one or more individuals wish to yield their time to a subsequent speaker, then in that event, the subsequent speaker shall be considered as a speaker for an organized group and shall be allowed a total of five (5) minutes only.
5. The Board shall designate a time keeper, who shall begin timing the speaker when the speaker states his or her name and will announce "time" when the allotted time has expired. The speaker shall stop at that time.
6. The speaker shall address the Board as a whole and shall not ask for any verbal exchange back from the Board. It is not the intent of public comments to require the Board to answer any impromptu questions. There shall be no discussion between the speakers and members of the audience.
7. All comments shall be in verbal form and the speaker shall not be allowed to play any recorded or video devices during such comments. All speakers are expected to observe the decorum of the Meeting, to be respectful in their language and presentation and to refrain from the use of profanity or shouting or from making disclosures prohibited by the Personnel Act with respect to any County employee. Willfully violation of the law or interrupting or disrupting of the meeting can result in criminal charges being brought under N.C.G.S. 143-318.17.

8. All comments by a speaker shall be limited to subjects that are within the jurisdiction of the Davie County Board of County Commissioners, or pertain to matters upon which it may act.
9. Topics which would require the Board to hold a closed session , *(including but not limited to matters within the attorney-client privilege, anticipated or pending litigation, personnel, property acquisition and matters which are made confidential by law)*, are not permitted as topics for public comments.
10. The speaker must make all presentations from the podium provided and shall not be allowed to physically approach the Board or staff member without the express invitation by the Chair or other designated presiding officer of the Board.
11. Any applause will be held until the end of the Public Comment Period.
12. A total of thirty (30) minutes shall be allocated by the Board for Public Comments at each regular monthly meeting of the Board of County Commissioners. Upon Motion duly made and adopted, the Board may extent the thirty (30) minute time period for any particular meeting.
13. If the time period runs out before all persons who have signed up to speak has had an opportunity to do so, then those names will be carried over to the next Public Comment Period.
14. This Policy on Public Comment shall be made available to the public 30 minutes before each regular monthly meeting and shall be placed on the County Website along with the public agenda of each regular monthly meeting at least 24 hours before each regular monthly meeting.

7. Presentations

There was one Presentation this evening:

Partners Update - Partners Behavioral Health Management - Jackie Copeland - Mr. Copeland is the Regional Director for Community Operations. He mentioned Partners has been busy trying to meet the needs of Davie County. Mr. Copeland offered a brief presentation. He mentioned it was day 125 since Partners has been serving Davie County. They have been working in Davie County since 11/1/2021. They focus on engaging the family and working with County departments. There is a 15.9% penetration rate (state average 14.5%). They serve Medicaid recipients and state funded recipients. 92 calls were received from individuals via the access to care line. 47 members have been served via Innovations. Unfortunately, there are 75 individuals who are registered but have unmet needs (not enough funding for services needed). Partners is engaging with the community to improve crisis services; Partners has helped to address the opioid addiction issue; they want to work collaboratively and proactively with Davie County.

8. Public Hearings

There were three (3) Public Hearings this evening:

1) Zoning Text Amendment 2022-01 - Director, Development and Facilities Services, Andrew Meadwell presented the Amendment request in which the Board will review a text amendment to the Zoning Ordinance in sections 155.125, 155.260, and 155.281 regarding table of uses, definitions and permit choice.

The Public Hearing was opened at 6:44 p.m. County Attorney, Ed Vogler, read the rules to speak during the Public Hearing. No one came forward to speak. The Public Hearing was closed at 6:45 p.m. Commissioner Jones made a motion to approve the amendment with the following statement: the amendment promotes public health, safety and general welfare; is consistent with all applicable adopted plans and considers the action to be reasonable and in the public interest; that said approval furthers the goals, objectives, actions and policies of the Land Development Plan and Growth Enhancement Strategy by clarifying permitted public uses, permit choice and definitions for vested rights. Commissioner Poindexter seconded the motion. All were in favor, and the motion passed 5-0 (Blakley, Renegar, Finney, Jones, Poindexter).

2) Zoning Text Amendment 2022-02. George Johnson III c/o Laura Mathis - Meadwell spoke about this amendment and stated

George Johnson III c/o Laura Mathis has applied to rezone approximately 2.57 acres consisting of three tracts from Residential-12 (R-12), Residential 20 (R-20) and Quality Design Overlay (R-12, R-20, QD-O) to Neighborhood Business, Quality Design Overlay (N-B, QD-O). The subject properties are located at 1832 Farmington Road. The properties are further described as Davie County Tax Parcels C500000107, C500000109 and C500000111.

The Public Hearing was opened at 6:48 p.m. County Attorney, Ed Vogler, spoke about the rules for the public hearing. Laura Mathis came forward and is available to answer questions. Ms. Mathis stated they are using the Johnson house and opening it up to the community which has a

direct link to the Farmington community. She stated most of the family lives out of state. They want to share the house with the community; they are trying to preserve the lots; they wish for the property to remain agricultural as possible. No one else came forward to speak. The Public Hearing was closed at 6:54 p.m.

Commissioner Jones made a motion that the following statement be adopted in support of a Motion to Approve;

The proposed zoning amendment is consistent with the Davie County Comprehensive Plan because:

1. A portion of the property is designated commercial on the 2019 plan.
2. The Comprehensive Plan policy goals to encourage planned development that mimics the existing architectural aesthetic of nearby land uses, ensures internal and external walkability and bikeability connections and complements nearby residential land use.

3. The property is indicated as a secondary growth area on the Growth Enhancement Strategy map within the Comprehensive Plan.

Therefore, we find this zoning amendment is reasonable and in the public interest because it supports the

Comprehensive Plan policies and maps above and because:

1. The property's location on Farmington Rd and near the NC HWY 801 intersection.
2. The property's location near other commercially zoned property and nonresidential uses such as the community center and church.

Commissioner Finney seconded the motion. All were in favor, and the motion passed 5-0 (Blakley, Renegar, Finney, Jones, Poindexter).

3) Voluntary Agricultural District and Enhanced Voluntary Agricultural District Ordinance - Eddie Leagans, Marsha McGraw and Henry Walker came forward to speak about this ordinance. They mentioned there is a need to update the ordinance due to changes to legislation at the State level. The last time the ordinance was updated was in 2021. The Agricultural District exists to promote agricultural values in Davie County. There are 56 designated farms with over 6693 acres in Davie County. They stated agriculture is the biggest revenue generator in the State of North Carolina.

The Public Hearing was opened at 7:03 p.m. County Attorney, Ed Vogler, read aloud the rules to speak during the public comments portion. No one came forward to speak and the Public Hearing was closed at 7:04 p.m.

Commissioner Poindexter made a motion to adopt the changes to the ordinance as proposed. Commissioner Jones seconded the motion. All were in favor, and the motion passed 5-0 (Blakley, Renegar, Finney, Jones, Poindexter).

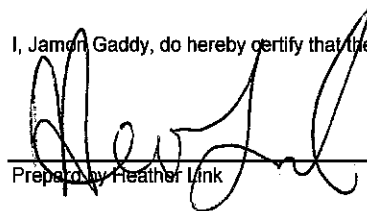
