At 4:45 p.m., Monday, March 7, the members of the Davie County Board of Elections met for a monthly meeting. Present were Gary LeBlanc, Faye Carter, Luther Potts, Robert Raisbeck, Carole Demmy, Melissa Parker and Tabatha Parrish.

Director Parrish reported to the Board that the request for reclassification of the Senior Elections Specialist position to Deputy Director is currently being evaluated in the salary study per Stacy Moyer, human resources director.

The Board reviewed an elections salary study prepared by Chatham County Board of Elections which included pay for board members and Election Day workers. The Election Day worker pay was increased in the previous fiscal year and was comparable to other counties in district 4, however board member pay was below average per the study. Robert Raisbeck moved to increase the board member stipend to \$75.00 for meetings and \$150.00 for Election Day and training days in the new fiscal year. The motion was unanimously approved.

Director Parrish reported to the Board that South Calahaln still has an opening for a Democratic Judge. The Democratic Party chair has been contacted for assistance with the search.

The minutes from the February 7 meeting were reviewed. Carole Demmy moved the approval of the minutes. The motion was unanimously approved.
