- DCRP has been taking the lead on developing a written Branding Style Guide for departmental and County use.

C. DIRECTORS REPORT

- DC Bike/Ped Planning project – Project team has concluded individual meetings with commissioners. Draft plan is out for review and editing.
- DCRP Community Recreation Agency grant application cycle opened on 12/15. In lieu of an in person workshop, the DCRP team developed a short How-To-Video for applicants who may be interested in applying. Video was uploaded to our webpage on 12/31.
- RiverPark at Cooleemee Falls – Contractor are on site and navigating clean up tasks. Executive committee continues working on future operational and sustainability plans.
- Following 12/14 advisory board meeting and consensus from members, DCRP continues development of an alcohol policy. CA and CM meeting was held on 1/7 to review a first draft. DCRP team to complete planning session on 1/12.
- Multiple County DHHS vaccine planning meetings are being held to site prep logistics and map out vaccination disbursement at DCCP in the month of January.
 - Our teams focus is proper and concise communication between the public, program participants, and how people can still access the park and programs without interrupting vaccination areas.
- The DC Board of Commissioners unanimously approved all new appointments and re-appointments to the DCRP Advisory Board.
- Volunteered at Farmington Disc Golf Course on 12/18 to install baskets and prep for opening weekend on 12/19.
- Held conference call with Georgina Lalivoda of Background Investigation Bureau on 12/21 to gauge their criminal background-screening product and cost comparison with our current product use with Protect Youth Sports.
