Programs & Athletics

Athletics

- Youth Basketball Leagues is underway!
 - We have 338 players to make up 38 teams across all Grade Division this season (most we have had for our department)
 - Games have been played for K-5th grade divisions with 6th-12th grade divisions games starting on January 6.
- Try LAX Clinic was held on December 5 (US Lax grant received to provide take on sticks and a ball) had 22 players.
- Free LAX Clinic: 12 players attended on Dec 20 and 9 attended on December 22. We have the last one scheduled for Sunday, January 23 from 2:00-3:30 p.m.
