

Davie County Board of Elections

Minutes for August 12, 2024

At 4:47 p.m., Monday, August 12, 2024 the members of the Davie County Election Board met for a regularly scheduled monthly meeting. Present were Gary LeBlanc, Ricky Jefferies, Luther Potts, Robert Raisbeck, Jr., Faye Carter (joining by teleconference), Melissa Parker and Leslie Robison. Also in attendance was one observer, Marge Walls-Walker.

Minutes of the previous board meeting held July 1, 2024 were reviewed. Motion was made by Luther Potts to accept and approve the minutes. All were in favor.

The meeting was open for public comments. There were none.

A resolution regarding the designation of duties to staff for the November 5th General Election was presented by Director Melissa Parker. This information had been previously delivered to the board members for their review. Faye Carter noted the letterhead was outdated. Motion was made by Robert Raisbeck, Jr. to accept and approve the resolution, subject to the correction of the letterhead. All were in favor.

Director, Melissa Parker, gave office updates. She informed the board of appointments by the MAT Team to visit assisted living facilities in the county and explained the MAT Team process. She also noted that Early Voting Judges will be appointed at the next meeting.

Chairman, Gary Leblanc, discussed the possibility of finding a larger space for Absentee Ballot counting. One possible location is the Senior Center next door. He also discussed exploring the possibility of expanding to the DMV office next door if they relocated. This would facilitate better training opportunities and adequate space needed during the election season.

The meeting was adjourned at 5:00 pm.
