

September 3, 2024, Minutes
Davie County Board of Elections

The Chairperson called the meeting to order.

At 4:45 p.m., Tuesday September 3, 2024, the members of the Davie County Board of Elections met for the regularly scheduled monthly meeting. Present were Gary LeBlanc, Chairperson, Ricky Jefferies, Luther Potts, Robert Raisbeck, Jr., Faye Carter, Melissa Parker, Director and Leslie Robison, Deputy Director. The minutes for August 12, 2024, were reviewed. Ricky Jefferies made a motion to approve the minutes, Luther Potts seconded, the motion carried unanimously.

Opening for public comments, however there was none presented.

Director Parker provided the board with the Early Voting Official Appointments. Robert Raisbeck, Jr., made a motion to approve the appointments, Luther Potts seconded, the motion carried unanimously.

Director Parker informed the board that Chief Judge at the Fulton Precinct, Renee Bradshaw will be unable to serve as Chief Judge due to illness. However, Brenda Seaford will serve as the Chief Judge. Debora Jones will serve as the Republican Judge and Tony Moore will be the Democratic Judge. Luther Potts made a motion to approve the Judges, Ricky Jefferies seconded, the motion was approved unanimously.

Director Parker gave the office updates. She informed the board of the appointments to visit all assisted living facilities in the county continues, MATT Team Leslie, Tiny and Debra Jones. Absentee Ballots start going out on Friday. At this point the office had 392 requests. The first Absentee Meeting will be held on October 1st at 5:00 p.m. The County Commissioners to adopt Resolution Establishing September 17, 2024, as National Voter Registration Day. The Staff will be holding A Voter Drive at DDCC from 9:00 am to Noon. Early voting official training will be held on September 26, 27 and 30th. DMV Lobby closed and public is now wanting to use the office lobby to get out of the heat.

There was no further business, the meeting adjourned at 5:30 p.m.
