Call to Order/Invocation: Paul Moore

Consent Agenda: Gaye Orsini made a motion to approve the Concert Agenda and minutes from the previous May meeting. Seconded by Rich Maconochie. Vote: 8-0 motion carried.

New Business:

- A) Alcohol Policy Update - Moore presented a motion to approve the amended language for the Alcohol Policy. Kacey Corriher made the motion to approve the updated policy language. The motion was seconded by Charles Kurfees. Vote: 8-0 in favor. Motion carried.
- B) Advisory Board Attendance - Moore informed the board that member Jared Vaughters has been unable to attend recent Advisory Board meetings. Moore will direct Ali Hartman to notify and consult with the Clerk regarding next steps in the potential removal process.
- C) System-Wide Tracking Update - Moore provided a progress update on key departmental initiatives, including: Land acquisition efforts, Greenway prioritization, Branding DCRP as a high-quality park system, Growth plan and talent structure development, and Expansion of quality-of-life programming
- D) Canopy TreeScape Project - Surveying for the Canopy TreeScape project is currently underway. The boardwalk design will be adapted with cost-efficiency in mind to minimize expenses.
- E) Budget Update - Moore noted that this is the final month of the fiscal year and shared the current standing in terms of budget percentages. He also informed the board of recent issues with the registration software provider, ActiveNet, but indicated that those issues are being worked on. Year-to-date financials were reviewed, and the department is expected to close the fiscal year in the green.
- F) 2026 Summer Concert Series Artist Recommendations - Moore opened the floor for suggestions regarding artists for the 2026 Summer Concert Series. Names mentioned included Tracy Lawrence, 38 Special, Sara Evans, and Rick Trevino. The board also discussed sponsorship opportunities for next year's concert season. Moore requested that any additional artist suggestions be submitted to him via email.

Miscellaneous: Moore reported that the June concert was a success, with attendance exceeding 3,000 people.
