At 5:00 p.m. Monday, November 8, the members of the Davie County Board of Elections met to review provisional ballots and absentee ballots that were received in the office after Monday, November 1 at 5:00 p.m., postmarked by November 2, and received no later than Friday, November 5. Present were Gary LeBlanc, Faye Carter, Luther Potts, Robert Raisbeck, Carole Demmy, Melissa Parker, and Tabatha Parrish.

One absentee ballot was reviewed and found to be timely received and properly executed. Luther Potts moved to approve the ballot. The motion was unanimously approved.

Seven provisional ballots were reviewed. Four ballots were found to be properly executed and eligible to count. Robert Raisbeck moved the approval of the ballots. The motion was unanimously approved. The approved ballots were removed from the envelopes and tabulated in the presence of the Board.

After due diligence in researching the remaining three provisional ballots, Director Parrish reported to the Board that the ballots were ineligible to be counted due to no record of registration. Robert Raisbeck moved to reject the ballots. The motion was unanimously approved.
