Absentee Ballot Meeting

November 7, 2022

Chair LeBlanc called the meeting to order.

Minutes: Rob moved that the November 1, 2022, minutes be approved as emailed. **Approved.**

Motion: Faye moved that the 150 properly executed absentee ballots be accepted. **Approved.** These ballots included 5 emailed OVR and 2 Military ballots which had to be duplicated.

In addition, a previously cured and received ballot was returned signed.

Motion: Gary moved that this be accepted. **Approved.**

Two ballots were spoiled.

As of the end of One-Stop voting on Saturday, November 5, 9,060 one-stop applications have been received.

Motion: Luther moved the acceptance of the one-stop applications. **Approved.**

As of October 31, 2022, there are 32,000 registered voters in Davie County.

The Jerusalem precinct Chief Judge Jamie Carter is not able to serve. Tina Phelps is willing to serve.

Motion: Carole moved that Tina Phelps be approved as Chief Judge at the Jerusalem precinct. **Approved.**

The meeting was adjourned.

The Board will meet tomorrow, November 6, Election Day, to visit precincts and to observe returning of locked ballot results.
