At 8:45 a.m., Tuesday, November 2, the members of the Davie County Board of Elections met for an Election Day meeting. Present were Gary LeBlanc, Luther Potts, Faye Carter, Rob Raisbeck, Carole Demmy and Tabatha Parrish.

Director Parrish reported to the Board that all precincts were open and running smoothly. The Democratic Judge in the North Mocks City precinct is the mother of a candidate and was replaced with a Democratic clerk for this Election. The Republican Judge in the South Mocksville precinct was unable to work due to illness and was replaced by the Republican clerk for this Election.

Upon confirmation of notary expiration date on absentee ballot, Luther Potts moved to approve the ballot. The motion and ballot were unanimously approved.

The Board reviewed the executed absentee ballot list. Chairman LeBlanc signed the Civilian Certificate of Oath to be forwarded to the SBOE

Meeting adjourned at 9:00 a.m. and the Board left the office to deliver official absentee ballot lists to the 4 precincts.

The Board returned to the office at 5:00 p.m. to tally the absentee by mail ballots. Present were Gary LeBlanc, Faye Carter, Luther Potts, Rob Raisbeck, Carole Demmy, Tabatha Parrish and Melissa Parker.

The Board removed the absentee ballots from the envelopes and the ballots were fed into the DS200 tabulator by Melissa Parker in the presence of the Board. Totals tapes were signed by the Board and ready for release by 7:30 p.m.

Totals were transferred to the absentee abstracts and signed by the Board to be mailed to the State Board of Elections. Meeting adjourned at 5:30 p.m.

Board remained at the office and without incident results were tallied and available on the web site by 9:30 pm.
