Athletics

- Mid-Eastern Martial Arts: 66 participants in September.

C. DIRECTORS REPORT

- Accessibility for Parks grant preparation continues. Deadline is 11/1. 60% complete.
- Park projects
 - DC Athletic Stadium LED Sign: COMPLETED
 - Phase II surveillance and security: Anticipated completion by January 2022
 - Ballfield scoreboard: Anticipated completion – Spring 2023
- Greenway feasibility study:
 - Avgol leadership is on board with future deed of easement when project funds come to fruition. Avgol has also expressed interest in a financial contribution for the project. .
 - Adoption by town and county commissioners anticipated in November or December.
- We are close to naming a new Customer Care Administrator, Athletic Program Director, and Recreation Specialist. Final interviews to be held on 10/11.
- Program Leader position was posted on 10/7.
- Davie County Athletic Stadium LED signage was installed and completed on 9/28.
- Splashpad winterization is underway and anticipated for completion by 10/14.
- Attended NRPA Conference 9/19-23.
- Concert talent contracts and riders for 2023 are under staff review. We anticipated finalization no later than 12/31.
