Absentee Meeting
October 4, 2022

Present: Luther Potts, Carole Demmy, Faye Carter, Rob Raisbeck, Gary LeBlanc, chair (via phone), Melissa Parker, Director, and Cindy Kirkus, Deputy Director

Rob Raisbeck conducted the meeting.

Absentee Ballots: 318 were mailed out. 57 returned.

Motion: Faye moved that we make sure the envelopes are correct. If not, we can duplicate, remail, or spoil. Motion approved.

Motion: Luther moved that we review the properly executed absentee ballots. Motion approved.

Motion: Faye moved that the spoiled ballot be disallowed. It was from a nursing home resident and was spoiled. It will be reissued and the MAT team will go to retrieve it. Motion approved.

Cindy explained how she dealt with returned ballots and the USPS. She was asked to keep notes and copies of correspondence so that her procedure would be validated.

The voting machines were tested and are ready to go.

Eight voter drives were scheduled; three have been completed.

The videography students filmed the L and A process. BOE will have a copy of the video when completed.

One-stop and Election Day training is in process.

Eleven students have responded to being an Election Official. Four have taken the next step.

Mock elections will be held October 6.

Cindy Kirkus was properly welcomed.

Absentee ballots were sent through the voting machine. Those that needed to be duplicated were done with the proper procedure.

The meeting was adjourned.
